On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2011, Vision Technical Molding was awarded a plaque of recognition for their acceptance into the CONN/OSHA SHARPS Program (Safety & Health Achievement Recognition Program). Vision is one of only nine companies in the state of Connecticut to have received this certification.
